General Rules

Management is on-site 24 hours and will address all complaints.

The Evergreens Campground is a registered historic site. Please respect the property and fellow campers.

No axes or saws are allowed at the campground. Please do not touch or cut any tree — dead or alive. Only burn wood that will fit in your fire ring... for your safety and the safety of others.

Guests departing early are responsible for all the time they reserved. There is no refund for early departures.

Pets are welcome but must be leashed and picked up after. Please bag their waste and place it in a campground trashcan. Do not leave pets unattended.

Quiet time at Evergreens Campground is 9:00 P.M. All noise must end at that time.

No car stereos are allowed at any time.

Management reserves the right to evict any person from the campground who violates the rules or otherwise creates a nuisance. No refunds will be issued.

You are responsible for any damage done to the cabins or any part of the campground.

The Evergreens Campground is not a party zone.

Fireworks of any kind are prohibited from the campground due to the high risk of fire (this includes sparklers).

Special fishing regulations apply to this section of the river. **Artificial Lures Only** are permitted. **No Live Bait.** Special length & bag limits are also in effect. Inquire at the office for complete and current rules.

Visitors Policy

Visitors must comply with all general rules.

Management reserves the right to limit the total amount of visitors to a site.

Visitors must park their vehicles at the office and walk into the site they are visiting. Visitors may not bring ATV's into the campground.

Visitors must register at the office and get a tag.

Visitor Fee is \$5.00 per person (children under 3 years old are free). There is no refund of the visitor fee.

Visitors may not bring dogs in to the campground and cannot leave their dog in the car at the office.

Visitors may not bring any trailer or towed vehicle in to the campground.

All visitors must leave the campground by 8:00 P.M. or they will be charged the site rate per person. No visitor vehicles can be left overnight.

Visitors may not check in prior to 9:30 A.M.

Visitors are solely responsible for their own safety and that of their children and belongings.

Registered campers who will not or cannot control their visitors will be asked to leave with their visitors.

Do not leave visitors unattended. They are your guests and you are responsible for them. Visitors must stay at your site.

ATV Policy

The Evergreens Campground allows quiet, four stroke, for wheel machines only.

No dirt bikes or scooters are allowed.

ATV's are allowed on driveways only. No riding is allowed in the campground, including to the bathhouse.

No starting of ATV's between 8:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M. If you return after 8:00 P.M., please idle back to your site and shut off your machine.

A parent or adult must accompany riders under 16, riding either directly in front or behind them.

All ATV riders under 18 years old must wear a helmet.

Please ride responsibly and respect landowner's rights.

Thoughtless acts result in land being shut down to ATV's.
